

MS Girls Open Track Season

The Golden Plains Middle School girls track team opened their season at the Northern Valley Invitational in Logan on April 14. The 7th and 8th grade girls combined for 40 points to place 6th at the meet.

Eighth grader Anais Cepeda placed in each of her events. She finished in second in the 1600m run with a time of 6:53.9. She placed third in the 800m run at 3:11.9, and fourth in Triple Jump with a distance of 25' 1". She was the anchor on the 800 medley relay with Braylee Knowles, Laura Moore, and Addy Wessel placing second with a time of 2:28.4.

"It was good to get the season started," said Cepeda. "Everyone worked hard and did their best. We hope to improve our times at the next meet to place higher in our events and as a team."

The 800m relay team of Moore, Marisol Perez, Estella Vargas, and Kailee Wessel also placed second with a time of 2:29.8 while the 400m relay team of Addy Wessel, Vargas, Kadalen Unrein and Perez placed fourth running 1:07.0.

Braylee Knowles placed fifth in Discus throwing 56' 2.5" and Moore placed sixth in the 100m dash in 14.95 seconds. Rounding out points for the girls was Kailee Wessel with sixth place in the 400m run at 1:24.1.

The girls will compete again at the Rawlins County Invitational in Atwood on April 21 where all grades 6-8 will compete together.
