Practice Time

Regular disciplined practice is needed. Practice guidelines are:

6th=60 minutes per week

7th=60 minutes per week

8th=60 minutes per week

These times are on a weekly basis. Students should complete their weekly practice time from one lesson to the next. Each student needs to determine the best day (s) for this to occur with their schedule. Students will have a weekly grade for this practice which also includes a parent signature. To qualify for the practice contest, the signature will be needed. The practice booklets will be given to the student at their first band lesson. We have full band rehearsals for just 30 minutes this year!

Our instrumental music department is interested in having students achieve to the best of their ability and enjoy music in the process. We hope you, as parents, will lend your support. Questions or suggestions are welcome. Feel free to call, email, or stop to see the director. Times can be arranged to talk to parents.

Grading System

Grading scale: A 92-100% B 82-91% C 72-81% D 64-71% F below 64%

Full Band Rehearsals: 5 points per day (if you have your equipment and behave well). Points are lost by being tardy to class, not having your equipment and not behaving in an appropriate manner.

Performances: 100 points per concert, contest, or marching event. These are REQUIRED events. The ensemble works for months for each one, and even one person missing can cause serious problems. Please make sure the concerts are listed on your calendar NOW to prevent any conflicts.

Lessons/Practice Time: 40 points total each week. This grade is based on remembering your lesson time and having your instrument and music at the lesson! Practice times are checked at each lesson on your assignment page. There again will be an extra credit question in each edition.

Tests/Assignments: 10-50 points each. These will include scale tests, concert song tests, as well as an occasional written test or assignment.

If students are interested, more than 60 minutes of practice per week will be needed!
