

MS Boys Tie for First at Northern Valley

The Golden Plains Middle School boys track team competed at the rescheduled Northern Valley Invitational track meet in Logan on April 29. The team including 7th and 8th grades combined, scored a total of 113 points to tie with Northern Valley for First Place.

Several of the boys took home first place medals including Diego Perez with a 1:04 run in the 400m, Maddix Green with a 2:51 PR run in the 800m, and both the 800m Relay with a 2:10 run by Owen Patmon, Tanner Black, Maddix Green, and Dominic Stout and the 800 Medley Relay running a 2:03 with Owen Patmon, Josh Rath, Diego Perez, and Dylan Wark running for the Bulldogs.

Adding second place points were Perez with a 31'1" Triple Jump and Dylan Wark in the 1600m run at 6:20. Third place finishes went to Wark with a 31'3" Triple Jump and in the 100m hurdles running a PR of 16.93. Green also placed third in the 1600m run with a time of 6:30. The 400m relay team of Tanner Black, Abe Taylor, Wyatt Amlong, and Dominic Stout placed third at 1:03 and Perez placed third in the 200m hurdles in 35.52 seconds.

Placing fourth was Wyatt Amlong in Shot Put (31' 1.75"), Josh Rath in the 100m dash (15.36), and Ezekiel Weiner in the 800m (3:18). Fifth place finishers included Rath-Long Jump (12'5"), Dominic Stout-Triple Jump (27' 0.5") 200m (31.31), Weiner-1600m (7:09), Aidan Pawlak-400m (1:30), and Green-200m hurdles (36.83).

Additional sixth place points were awarded to Owen Patmon-Long Jump (11'6"), Rath-Triple Jump (26' 7.5"), and Amlong-Discus (78' 8"). The Bulldogs continued their season in Quinter on April 30.
