Multiples Photoshoot Planning Sheet

Assignment: Students must create a photo that uses multiple versions of the same person. It can be yourself or it can be a peer.

How to do it: Student must take first photo either in front of the backdrop or in a certain location. Student can also use a photo previously taken as the base photo. Then, student must take multiple photos in front of the backdrop of same person in different poses. Bring the photos into photoshop,



cut out the individuals and have them interact with the giant version of self.

Step 1: What is your concept?

Step 2: What is your base photo going to be?

Step 3: List or draw the poses the multiples need to be doing?


Step 4: Take photos needed for assignment.

Step 5:

Bring photos into photoshop, cut out the individuals using the magic wand or quick selection tool and place them in your base image. Make sure they are interacting with base image.

Step 6:

To make a shadow of a character, duplicate the layer. Select person, fill with black, then make the opacity 50%. Flip the shadow upside down.





What I am grading:

- 1. One base photo used for assignment (large photo of person)
- 2. At least 4 smaller versions of same person used
- 3. Every person is in a different pose
- 4. Coloring and lighting is consistent
- 5. Craftsmanship (everything cut out nicely, looks clean and real)
