Gilbert Heights students can check out library books from the Multnomah County Library.



From the Multnomah County Library you can:

- ★ Borrow physical books
- ★ Download an eBook
- ★ Download audiobooks
- ★ Access research resources (encyclopedias)
- ★ Get online homework help
- ★ Stream movies or music

It is easy!

You just use your school ID number. Follow these steps.

Step 1 - Go to this website - https://multcolib.org/libraryconnect/elementary-school-grades-k-5

Step 2 - You can scroll through this page to see the different options.

Step 3 - Your Library Connect ID number is the number 40 followed by your DD Student ID For example - 40765432

Step 4 - Your password is your birth date - two digits for the month, two digits for the day, four digits for the year you were born. For example - 01312008.

(If you already had a Multnomah Library account, then they've merged your accounts and you'll use your student ID but then the password you had already created for your account, instead of your birthdate.)

Click on the "Go to Catalog" button to check out physical books, DVDs and eBooks. You'll need to click the login button in the upper right corner.

Scroll down the page for more eBook and streaming options. Directions about how to access are included there.

If you need your Library account info for any of these apps or sites, you use the same one described on the previous slide.
