Each page was designed to correspond to each lesson's writing application of CKLA Domain 2: Five Senses. I added a wrap-up page to close the book up on the domain review and assess day.

I do not have an example, but I will have students complete simple drawings to match the prompts based on what we learned. I have them complete one page at a time, and then at the end I like to bind their books all at once to send home.

Taste: I included two pages, but I feel like sweet and sour are easy to draw. I will only complete that page. However, the prompt includes salty and bitter so I included those pages as an option.

Touch: The kids could draw a dog and say it feels fluffy / furry / soft. So the teacher / kid would complete the sentence like: This is a dog and it feels fluffy.

Printing Tips: I tried my best to maintain one inch margins, but for best printing select "scale to fit paper" or "fit."
