**Exposition:** We meet Nadia, who is willful, her favorite brother, Hamed, and her father, Tarik, who is the sheik of Nadia's clan. The story takes place in a desert, possibly in the Middle East or northern Africa.

**Falling Action:** Tarik gathers the clan and re-names his daughter "Nadia the Wise."

**Resolution:** The shepherd returns, and the people of the clan live happily, holding on to Hamed in their hearts and minds.
