WHAT ARE NASA INTERSHIPS?

NASA internships provide unique NASA-related experiences for high school, undergraduate, graduate students, and educators. They engage students with real-world experiences while contributing to the operation of a NASA facility and the advancement of NASA's missions. Some internships pay students a weekly stipend and some a salary, but it varies depending on the center, funding organization and internship program.



Pathways Internship Program

The Pathway Program provides current students and recent graduates with paid work experience and a dynamic development opportunity at the beginning of their careers. Pathways provides three programs:

- NASA Pathways Intern Employment Program
- NASA Pathways Recent Graduates Program
- NASA Pathways Presidential Management Fellows Program
