National Business Honor Society

The object and purposes of the organization, organized as a chapter of the NBEA National Business Honor Society, are to:

- promote and recognize academic achievement in business education at Algonquin Regional High School;
- foster and recognize leadership skills and character development;
- help members grow ethically and socially by promoting and encouraging an interest in business; and
- encourage member involvement in service learning initiatives.

To qualify for active membership, a student must be a high school junior or senior. The student must have completed or be currently enrolled in his/her third business education course. The student must have a minimum standard GPA as follows: business courses average of 4.0; overall average of 3.5. A student must complete their third business course by the end of Semester 1 of the eligibility year in order to qualify for active membership.

Membership in the chapter is attained through a selection process coordinated by the local chapter board. Selection for membership is based on outstanding scholarship, character, leadership, and service. Members are expected to continue to demonstrate these qualities throughout their membership in the society.
