English as a Second Language Certification program is coming to Newark Public Schools

START YOUR ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM IN SPRING 2022

Montclair State University's Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) Certification Program will offer Newark Public School teachers a fully online, non-degree program of study leading to New Jersey Department of Education English as a Second Language Certification. The program prepares certified teachers to teach ESL in addition to their first-field certification. The TESL program sequence consists of six fully online courses offered during after-school hours.

Participants will be required to complete the following courses:

- APLN 500: Language and Linguistics
- APLN 520: Current Theories of Second Language Acquisition
- APLN 524: Advanced Structure of American English
- APLN 525: Methodology of TESL
- APLN 529: TESL Practicum
- APLN 532: Language and Culture

Requirements for admission:

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college/university
- 3.0 GPA (graduation date after September, 2016); 2.75 GPA (graduation date prior to September, 2016)
- Current teaching certification
- Official academic transcripts
- Passing scores on the oral and written language proficiency tests in English (*Not required for admission, but must be completed prior to program completion.*)
- Computer with internet access (for online course participation)
