Call for Poster Presentations, Free Communication Presentations, Round Table Communication Sessions and, Emerging Scholars Symposium

Submit a Proposal for the 2015 NCPEID Annual Conference Submissions Due April 15th, 2015

The NCPEID organizes peer-reviewed, competitively selected presentations for its annual National Conference program under four primary categories.

Poster Presentations:

- Proposal abstract length: 250-300 words
- Posters should present current research, or most current research related issues such as advocacy, professional development, or other areas.
- Poster presentation proposals should include the following sections and/or headers:
 - Title; Authors, Affiliation, Contact information; Introduction/Purpose; Methodology; Results/Discussion; Summary/Conclusions
- The poster should be no larger than 2' x 4' in size. *NCPEID will provide poster putty*. Poster Presentation authors should plan to bring handouts of poster material such as the reference list and the poster content, a one page abstract with author contact information, business cards, etc., to give to those interested.

Free Communications Presentations:

- Proposal abstract length: 250-300 words indicating preferred presentation format.
- Free communications should be centered on research, best practices, advocacy, grant seeking, or other areas and be formatted as oral presentation, 15-20 minutes in duration.

Round Table Communication Session

- Proposal abstract length: 250-300 words indicating preferred presentation format.
- Lead one 30-minute collaborative presentation and discussion that build resources for the membership (e.g., white papers, position statements, shared ideas, best practices, etc.) and enhance the organization's efforts to address current issues facing the profession.

Emerging Scholars Symposium:

- Proposal abstract length: 250-300 words
- This session is dedicated to students and practitioners who are actively engaged in the research process and are seeking feedback from scholars in the field.
 - Note: Presenters accepted for the Emerging Scholars Symposium might have all of their conference fees waived.
- Emerging Scholars Symposium will be designed in the following format:
 - Students or practitioners orally presenting their research in progress to the entire audience (5-8 min per presenter).
 - Followed by a 20-minute breakout poster session format at their poster area, where the emerging scholars receive additional feedback and inquiries individually from audience members.
 - Poster presentation proposals should include the following sections and/or headers:
 - Title; Authors, Affiliation, Contact information; Introduction/Purpose; Methodology; Preliminary Findings/Results/Discussion (if applicable); Summary/Conclusions (if applicable)
 - O The poster should be no larger than 2' x 4' in size. NCPEID will provide poster putty. Poster Presentation authors should plan to bring handouts of poster material such as the reference list and the poster content, a one page abstract with author contact information, business cards, etc., to give to those interested.

Please use the following online submission form to submit your proposal. If you would like to submit more than one proposal, please re-launch the submission link from the NCPEID website www.ncpeid.org and submit the additional proposal(s) separately.

Note that ALL presentation proposals for the 2015 NCPEID National Conference should be *submitted by April 15, 2014*. Presenters will be notified of acceptance by May 1, 2014.
