

Judge Ned Fenlon Scholarships

At least three \$500.00 scholarships will again be awarded to seniors attending any of the Emmet County public high schools: Alanson, Harbor Springs, Mackinaw City, Pellston and Petoskey. A minimum of two will be awarded based on academic achievement, school/community service, extracurricular activities, and an essay. The student will be attending a community/junior college or a four-year degree-granting college/university. A 2.7 G.P.A is required. One will be awarded to a senior attending a vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification or license or a community/junior college or a college/university that offers vocational training. A 2.0 G.P.A. is required.

These scholarships honor Long-time Circuit Judge and Democratic State House Representative, Ned Fenlon. Judge Fenlon died in 2010 at 106 years old. Print the scholarship application as provided. Mail the completed application to the address on the form. It must be postmarked no later than April 15th. No fax or email applications will be accepted.
