


1. The District is working on art supplies

1. In the meantime, all you need is a school Chromebook, a stack of paper, pencils, and erasers.






**Feel free to ask your family** if you can go to a dollar store. You'll find lots of art supplies there for a more reasonable cost!

Ask for some paper bags from the grocery store, or cardboard boxes. Crayons look GREAT on brown paper bags and cardboard!














## Make temporary drawings and messages on the sidewalk with water!

What kind of cardboard recycling does your house have?




