THE NELLE L. BALL TRUST SCHOLARSHIP

DEFINITION:

In order to inspire and encourage individuals to seek education and training beyond the secondary level, THE NELLE L. BALL TRUST, WELLSTON, OHIO, has established a scholarship award to be offered to interested young men and women desiring the pursuit of higher educational goals and training in their selected field of endeavor.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants **MUST** meet the following requirements in order to apply for the scholarship:

- Be a Wellston High School senior planning to enroll in an accredited university, college, or community college.
- Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.33 or higher.
- Application due MARCH 21, 2025, to the high school office.
- All accepted applicants that meet the above criteria **will** go through a formal interview process. These individuals will be notified, via letter, as to the date, time, and location of the formal interview.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Scholarship funds may be applied to studies at any accredited institute of higher learning (community college, in-state or out-of-state college or university, or vocational training program).
- The recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student as defined by the college selected.
- In the event the recipient either (1) withdraws from college; or (2) is asked to withdraw, the matter will be reviewed by the trustees. Distribution of the remaining funds, if any, will be determined at that time.
- Emphasis on reviewing candidates for a scholarship will be placed on achievement and financial need.
- The decision of the Scholarship Trust is final.

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- The amount of the scholarship or scholarships will be variable from year to year, depending on the funds available and the merit and need of applicants.
- A check for the amount of the scholarship will be made directly to the student and their university for the use of college expenses: tuition, books, and general expenses after proof of enrollment is cleared by the treasurer of the trust.
- If the student transfers to a different institution, any remaining funds may be transferred with the student following the scholarship committee review.
- Use of these funds must begin within one year from the date of the award of the scholarship.

 - a. Official cumulative transcript from high school reflecting G.P.A. through the first semester of the senior year.

 - c. Three written recommendations:

 - a. An individual associated with the community
