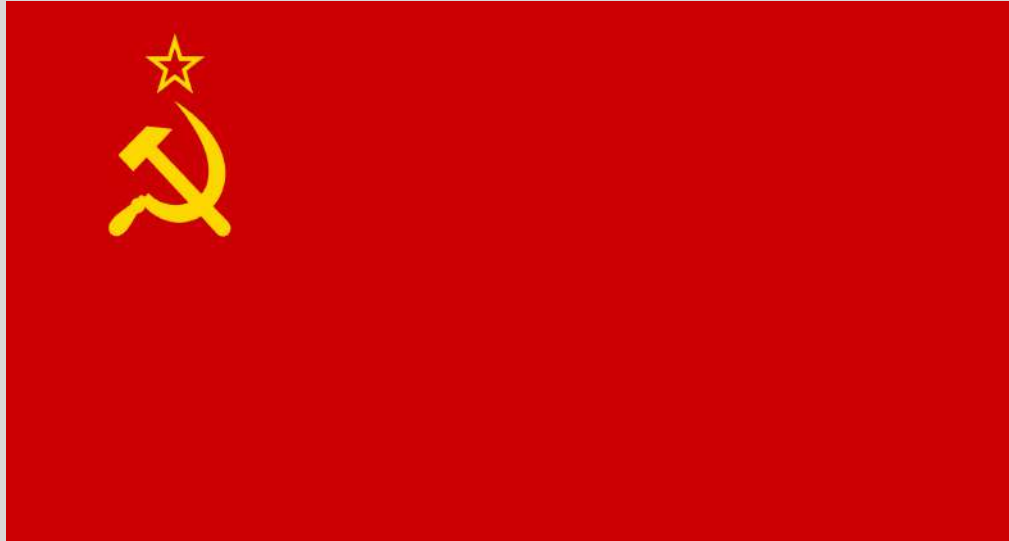

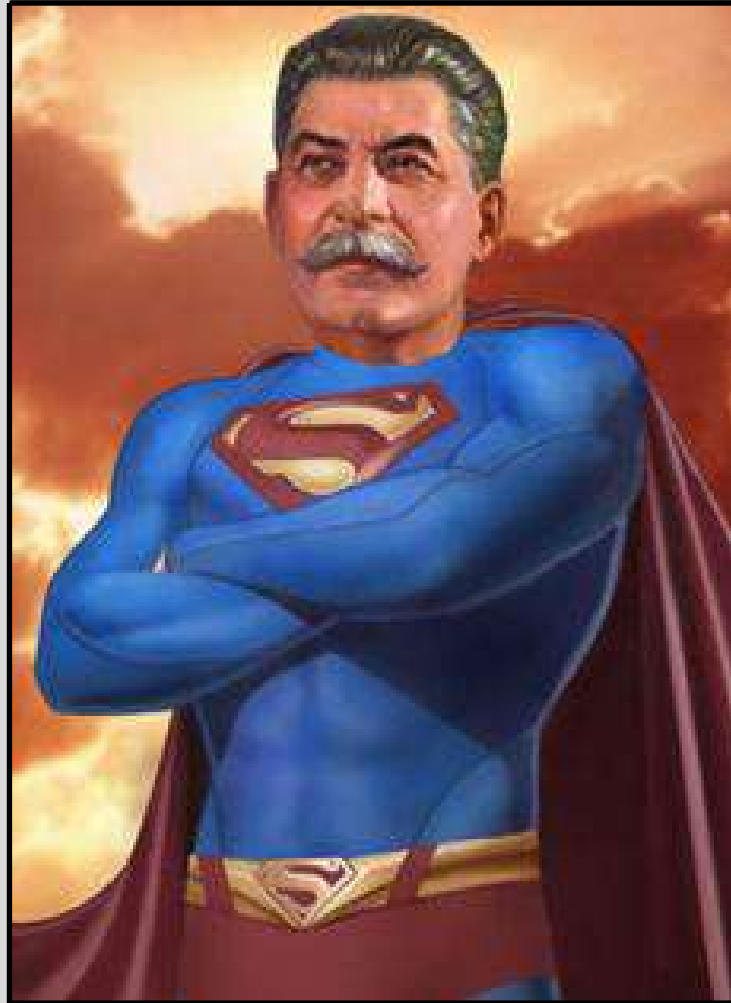

The Death of Trotsky and the Rise of Stalin

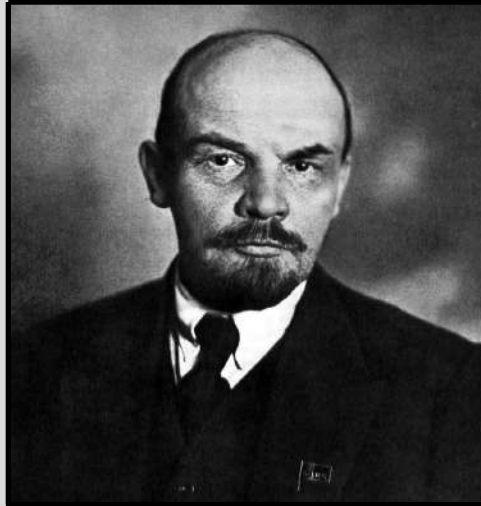

Joseph Stalin and the USSR

How did Stalin differ?

Lenin and Trotsky believed in a **world revolution**



Stalin believed in a **Russian Revolution**, the rest of the world could wait.

What did Stalin do?

Convinced that someday foreign enemies would attack the USSR, he began to industrialize through his **Five Year Plan**.
