MORNING ARRIVAL



- Student arrival in the morning is 7:00 a.m. 7:30 a.m. Students may not enter the building prior to 7:00 a.m.
- Students are encouraged to ride the bus. The bus typically arrives to the school between 7:00 7:10 a.m.
- Students arriving in the car must exit independently on the sidewalk. Teacher Assistants are stationed on the sidewalk to assist.
- All students have the opportunity to eat breakfast in the school cafeteria.
- Students are considered "Tardy" if they are not in the classroom when the bell rings at 7:30 a.m.

- All Weddington parents and students will sign a form acknowledging they have read and understand the information.


CORE SUBJECT TIMES
