What are we learning?

Positivity Project: Next week we will learn how Other People Matter and how our words and actions impact others.

Letterland: In Unit 3 we will learn about suffixes (-ing and -s) and double consonants at the end of words, otherwise known as best friends on the end such as -ll, -ff, -ss.

Math: In math we will continue learning about mental strategies for adding and subtracting numbers such as, counting on, creating an easier problem, doubles, making 10 and using the opposite operation. **OUR ASSESSMENT FOR UNIT 1 IS ON WEDNESDAY!** Unit 2, which we begin on Thursday, focuses on the partners of 10 and 100.

EL: We will read The Invisible Boy and we'll describe what happens in the text to the main character. We will also respond to questions using details from the text.

Science: We will continue our unit on sound! Specifically, students will explore the relationship between sound and objects of the body that vibrate (eardrums and vocal cords).
