Last weekend more than 20 public school teachers from Newark and Jersey City got rocking and rolling during a twoday music workshop designed to help them bring music back to their schools.

The teachers were taking part in a curriculum-training program at Cleveland Elementary School and offered by Little Kids Rock, a nonprofit organization that restores music education to underfunded public schools.

Little Kids Rock has donated more than \$140,000 worth of instruments, music curriculum and music education resources to the schools. The teachers spent the weekend learning the music curriculum they will implement at their schools, many of which have lost those programs due to budget cuts.

"Both school districts have very dedicated teachers who will undoubtedly transform their children's lives with the resources that we will provide to them," said Little Kids Rock executive director David Wish.
