- ❖ Given continued **HIGH RATES** of Community Spread in Lawrence, the return of selected HIGH NEEDS students is occurring as a very limited and controlled phased-in approach
- ❖ ENHANCED PPE and PROTOCOLS are in place including Daily Temperature Checks and the **Abbott Binax Now Rapid Antigen Test** Binax for symptomatic students and staff

**HIGH NEEDS STUDENTS** are matched with **STAFF MEMBERS** completing the INTEREST TO RETURN Survey

- In total, **414 STAFF MEMBERS** indicated interest in returning In Person.
- Principals prioritized High Needs learners matched to In Person staff members to include the following groups:
  - Special Education Students assigned to District Programs
  - Newcomer English Learners
  - Homeless Students or those living in Foster Care
  - Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten Students
  - Other HIGH NEEDS students experiencing connectivity or remote learning challenges
  - The schedule for In-Person learning is **MONDAY – FRIDAY (same hours as remote)**

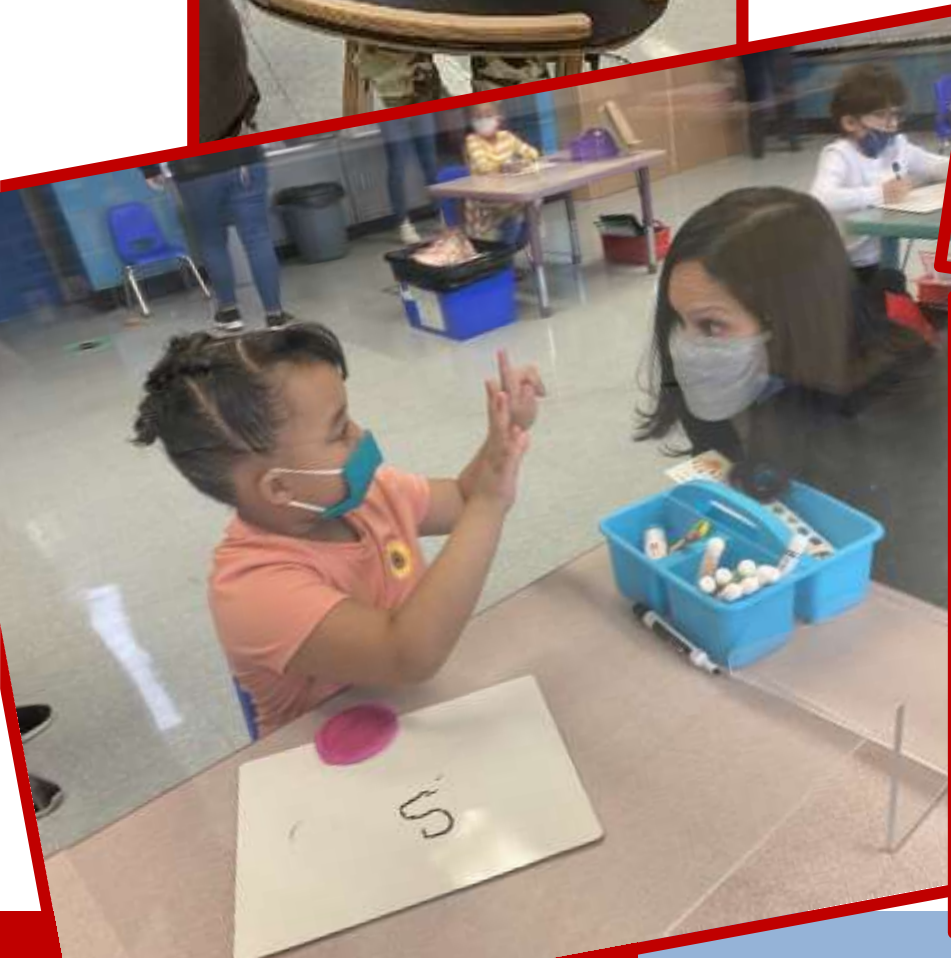

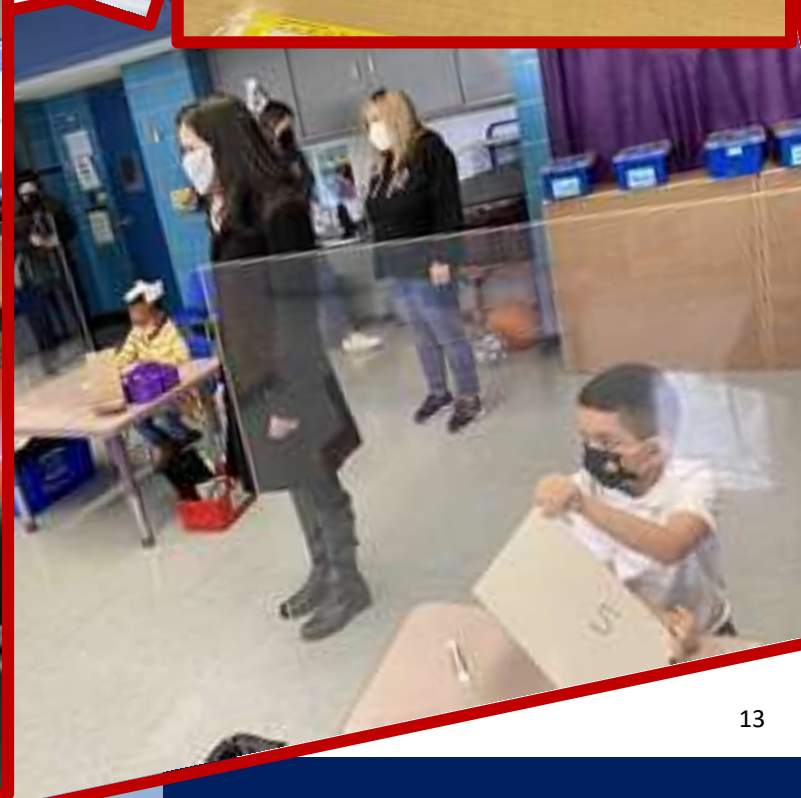
