**Social Studies:** learning about geography, landforms, location, symbols, maps, environment, regions, and natural resources.

## Vocabulary

### Social Studies:

1. **absolute location**- the exact spot where a place is located
2. **grid map**- a map with lines that cross to make squares to tell the location of a place
3. **symbol**- an object that stands for something else a picture that stands for something real
4. **cardinal directions**- the four main directions on Earth (north, south, west, east)
5. **continent**- consists of the seven largest areas of land on Earth
6. **oceans**- consists of the four largest bodies of water on Earth
7. **globe**- a round or spherical model of the Earth
8. **equator**- an imaginary line that divides the Earth in half horizontally; the Southern and Northern Hemispheres
9. **prime meridian**- an imaginary line that divides the Earth in half vertically; the Eastern and Western Hemispheres
10. **world map**- a flat drawing of the Earth
