I often write about making sure we support our students with their nightly reading minutes, and I also wanted to share some ideas for supporting our students with math. Here are some helpful tips:

- · Look for shapes and patterns in everyday life
- · Have your child measure ingredients
- Ask your child to explain what they are doing in math (and don't take "nothing" as answer. I assure you, your child is doing something in math;-)
- · Play card games and board games
- Do a lot of comparing, ask which is tallest, heaviest, smallest, hottest, etc.
- Have your child chart or graph things they are doing teeth brushing, sleep, animal feeding, etc.

These are just simple things, but they just might be the activity that really boosts an idea or concept in your child's mathematical reasoning.
