NOTES FROM MRS. WILLIAMS

I often write about making sure we support our students with their nightly reading minutes, and I also wanted to share some ideas for supporting our students with math. Here are some helpful tips:

- Look for shapes and patterns in everyday life
- Have your child measure ingredients
- Ask your child to explain what they are doing in math (and don't take "nothing" as answer. I assure you, your child is doing something in math;-)
- Play card games and board games
- Do a lot of comparing, ask which is tallest, heaviest, smallest, hottest, etc.
- Have your child chart or graph things they are doing - teeth brushing, sleep, animal feeding, etc.

These are just simple things, but they just might be the activity that really boosts an idea or concept in your child's mathematical reasoning.
