## Instructions for 7th Grade Registration Card

Our school day consists of six class periods that meet every day of the week. The school year consists of two 20 week semesters.

**ACADEMIC COURSES:** Every student will be assigned four academic classes. The classes are Language Arts, Science, World Geography, and Math. Students will be placed in the appropriate Math course based on course taken in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Please provide documentation/current copy of report card from previous school.

#### REQUIRED WELLNESS COURSES: PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH

These courses are required for all seventh grade students and will not be waived to take additional 20 week elective courses. In the case a 7<sup>th</sup> grader wishes to take two full year elective courses - *a full year of Music along with a Level 1 World Language only* - the Physical Education and Health requirement may be waived.

• Please be aware that once enrolled in 7<sup>th</sup> grade full-year music and language, it is not an option to drop either class during that school year.

### ELECTIVE COURSES: Students will take 1 full-year elective OR 2 semester electives. \*

- If your choice is 1 full year elective, please rank the order of the choice of your World Language elective (1-4) or mark an "X" next to the music course choice.
- If your choice is 2 semester electives, the 20-week elective classes must be ranked in order of preference (1-6).
- \*If your choice is a full year Music class <u>and</u> a full year World Language class, mark an "X" by your music choice and rank your World Language choices.

**MUSIC**: Band 7 or Orchestra 7 should only be selected if Band/Orchestra was taken in 6<sup>th</sup> grade or special arrangements have been made through the instructor. No experience necessary to choose Choir.

WORLD LANGUAGE: Students have the opportunity to begin learning a Level 1 World Language in 7<sup>th</sup> grade; however, it is **not** a required elective in 7<sup>th</sup> grade (students will also have an opportunity to begin Level 1 Language in 8<sup>th</sup> or high school). Students successfully completing the Level 1 language course in 7<sup>th</sup> grade can then take Level 2 of that language in 8<sup>th</sup> grade or in high school. Students receive a high school credit for passing this course. For this reason, they should be organized students who are capable of handling a **high school level** work load. The grade they receive in this course will be on the high school transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into the high school grade point average (GPA). Please be aware that once enrolled in 7<sup>th</sup> grade language, it is not an option to drop the language class during that school year and switch to another elective.

\*If choosing to begin a Level 1 World Language class, please sign and attach "High School Course Agreement" form to the scheduling card.

NOTE: Students with IEP's: Certain requirements or course options may be altered as a result of an IEP.

- 1. Discuss with and assist your child in making the appropriate elective class selections.
- 2. Fill out the registration card completely and include required signatures on form(s).
- 3. Provide documentation/a copy of current report card from previous school.
