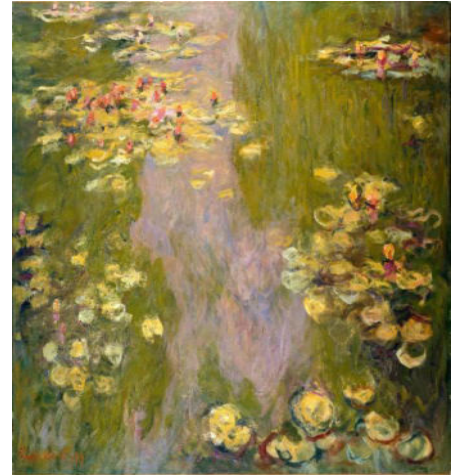

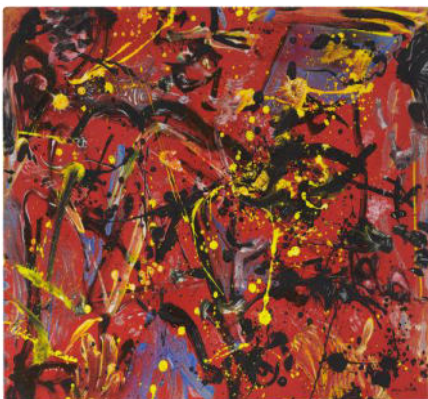
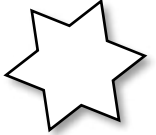

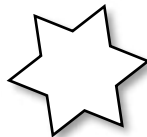

*V-J day in Time Square*, 1945



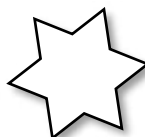

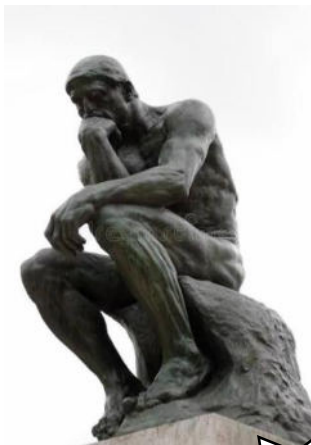

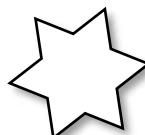

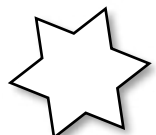

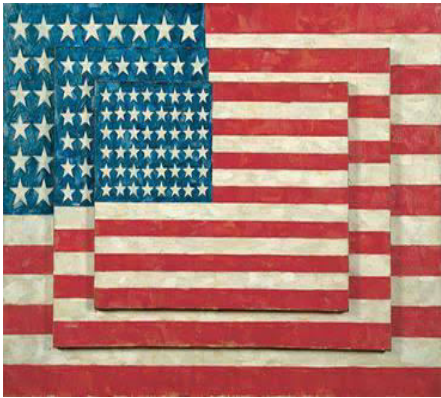

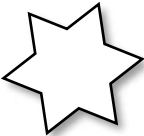

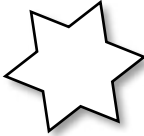

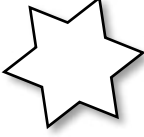

*Guardian Jade Lion, Ming Dynasty era*



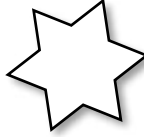

*Crying Girl, 1963*



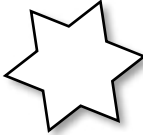
Rapa Nui people, Eastern Polynesia  
*Moai, Easter Island Head statues, between 1250 and 1500*



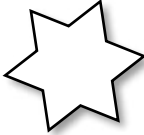
