

Guidelines North American Colonies

#1 Studies through Vocabulary (Flashcards: 10 points)

Student writes out all vocabulary terms on one side of the flashcard, with the definition for each term on the opposite side. Use pg. 108-135.

Words: proprietor, barter, export, import, raw materials, slavery, Middle Passage, uprising, King Philip's War, ally, treaty, Proclamation of 1763.

Points are earned for correctly identifying the term for the definition the teacher reads. The teacher will test you over at least 5 of the 12 terms.

#2 Social Studies through a Choral Poem. (Poem: 10 points)

Practice and present the poem "My Favorite Time" in pairs. Two students need to read the poem aloud using eye contact and loud voices. Read this poem as a choral, meaning together. Have parts of the poem memorized, so you are able to use eye contact with the audience. Present poem to the class.

#3 Social Studies through Mapping. (Map: 10 points)

Color code and label the 13 colonies. Use proper spelling for the colonies and use the proper abbreviation for that state also. Follow the directions at the top of the worksheet. Mrs. Stein will quiz you over 5 of the locations of 5 different states/colonies.

#4 Social Studies through a Board game (10 points)

Read the directions on how to make the board game, “Sail on the Mayflower”. Play the board game cooperatively TWICE. Mrs. Stein will ask you this test question: What were some experiences of the pilgrims, as they made their voyage to America?

#5 Social Studies through Reading. (10 points)

Follow the directions at the top of the worksheet. Take the pre-reading true/false quiz. Read through the magazine, *Colonial America*. Recheck your true/false test and make the false statements true. Turn into the tray.

#6 Social Studies through Mapping. (Map: 10 points)

Follow the directions on the front of the plantation map. Use the clues/descriptions to number the plantation map. Turn into the tray.

#7 Social Studies through Videos. (10 points)

Go to my website, Social Studies, North American Colonies, #7 The Thirteen Colonies Videos. Watch 3 video clips: The New England Colonies, Middle Colonies and Southern colonies. Fill out the 3 corresponding charts and turn them into the tray.

#8 Social Studies through Reading/Writing (Timeline: 10 points)

Lesson 4 The French and Indian War: Read pg 130-135 in your workbook. Answer Questions #1-7 as you read. Put your workbook on the back counter.
