DISCIPLINE PLAN

Inappropriate behaviors at Northeast Middle fall into 4 categories or levels of offenses. Each level is addressed either by the classroom teacher or school administration.

Examples of Level 1 Offenses

- Handled by the teacher Follow classroom discipline plan; Documentation of the behavior. (Ex. Warning)
- 2nd/3rd Offense Parent contact by classroom teacher (Ex. Timeout in another room)
- 4+ Offenses = Repeat Offender Referral to office

Examples of Level 2 Offenses

- Handled by the teacher with documentation of the behavior.
- Parent contact by classroom teacher
- Repeat Offender Referral to office/removal from class

Examples of Level 3 Offenses

- Handled by administration. **Direct office referral** with accompanying referral form.
- Parent contact by administrator or teacher (TBD)- Phone call with consequence (Ex. Restricted specials, lunch and/or recess; Partial day ISS → OSS)

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

Classroom

- Level 1 and Level 2 behaviors handled by the teacher.
 - The teacher will follow individual classroom hierarchies of behavior management.
 - At least 3 interventions/strategies (one must be a parent contact) must be implemented before writing a referral.
 - Documentation and data collection are required. (Note previous interventions on referral)

School Administration

- Level 3 behaviors handled by administration.
 - Results in a direct office referral.
 - An administrator or teacher (TBD) will contact student's parent with consequence.
 - An appropriate consequence will be given as decided by administration

In an emergency situation, the student may be brought straight to the office. If the teacher is unable to bring the student, the office will be contacted and an administrator will come to the classroom and remove the student.

Prior to an Office Discipline Referral:

- 1. Parents and students must know teacher expectations and procedures.
- 2. Parents and students must know the classroom teacher's discipline plans and procedures.
- Teachers must document unacceptable behaviors and consequences imposed, trying several strategies/interventions to stop the inappropriate behavior. Documentation of parent communication and strategies should accompany referral.
- 4. All Level 3/Safe School Violations warrant an immediate office referral. A completed office referral form must accompany the student to the office.

Bullying Definition

- 1. <u>Intent to Cause Harm</u> actions done by accident are not bullying; the person bullying (aggressor) has a goal to cause harm, NOT AN ACCIDENT
- 2. <u>Imbalance of Power</u> the aggressor uses their power--physical or emotional--or status to control or harm and the people being targeted may have a hard time defending themselves.
- 3. Repetition incidents of bullying happen to the same person more than once by the same person or a group of people
