



**AGREEMENT
FOR INTERDISTRICT COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES
2012 - 2013 SCHOOL YEAR**

This Agreement is hereby entered into by and between the Northwest Career & Technical Academy, Mount Vernon School District No. 320, Skagit County, Washington, which is hereinafter referred to as the "Serving District," and

**Concrete School District No. 011, Skagit County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as the
"Participating District."**

The purpose of this Agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.355.160, RCW 28A.225.250, and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by attendance at the Northwest Career & Technical Academy programs including the following:

- Academy of Finance
- Academy of Sustainable Engineering - Mount Vernon Campus & Meridian High School
- Construction Careers - Meridian High School
- Culinary Arts
- Dental Technology
- DigiPen Video Game Programming
- Marine Technology - Anacortes Marine Tech Campus
- Medical Technology
- Veterinary Technology

Unless noted all programs take place on the Mount Vernon Campus






This agreement is for the **2012-2013** school year, beginning on or before **September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013**, and was approved by each respective Board of Directors.
