AR VERBS

(Present Tense)

✓ The INFINITIVE form of a verb is the BASE, ORIGINAL form of the verb

✓In English the INFINITIVE is "TO _____" (do something/action) In SPANISH

In Spanish there are THREE types of INFINITIVES: AR, ER, & IR verbs (those are endings of the verbs)

✓ We will first talk about AR VERBS

Rules for Conjugating AR Verbs

1. First: Take the "AR" ending off of the verb

2. **Next**: Check who the subject of the sentence is (the person doing the action)

3. **Last**: Add the correct ending to match the subject of the sentence (who is doing the action)

Review: Subject Pronouns

• Yo -

Nosotros – We

• Tú – You

Vosotros- You all

• Él - He

Ellos - They

• Ella – She

Ellas - They (fem.)

Ud. – You (polite)

Uds. -

You all

AR Verb Endings

Yo: O Nosotros: AMOS

Tú: AS Vosotros: ÁIS

Él Ellos

Ella: A Ellas: AN

Ud. Uds.

Example: PRACTICAR

Yo: practico Nosotros: practicamos

Tú: practicas Vosotros: practicáis

Él Ellos

Ella: practica Ellas: practican

Ud. Uds.
