AR VERBS

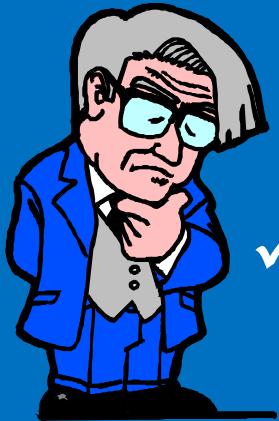
(Present Tense)

✓ The INFINITIVE form of a verb is the
BASE, ORIGINAL form of the verb

✓ In English the INFINITIVE is
"TO _____" (do something/action)
In SPANISH

✓ In Spanish there are THREE types of
INFINITIVES: **AR**, **ER**, & **IR** verbs
(those are endings of the verbs)

✓ We will first talk about **AR** VERBS



Rules for Conjugating AR Verbs

1. **First:** Take the “AR” ending off of the verb
2. **Next:** Check who the subject of the sentence is (the person doing the action)
3. **Last:** Add the correct ending to match the subject of the sentence (who is doing the action)

Review: Subject Pronouns

- Yo – I
- Tú – You
- Él - He
- Ella – She
- Ud. – You (polite)
- Nosotros – We
- Vosotros- You all
- Ellos - They
- Ellas - They (fem.)
- Uds. - You all

AR Verb Endings

Yo: **O**

Nosotros: **AMOS**

Tú: **AS**

Vosotros: **ÁIS**

Él

Ellos

Ella: **A**

Ellas: **AN**

Ud.

Uds.

Example:

PRACTICAR

Yo: practico

Nosotros: practicamos

Tú: practicas

Vosotros: practicáis

Él

Ellos

Ella: practica

Ellas: practican

Ud.
