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However, all such strategy discussions must be necessary for competitive or bargaining reasons and may not include competitive or bargaining adversaries. IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2) For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety and security measures, plans, and systems. IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(3) Interviews and negotiations with industrial or commercial prospects or agents of industrial or commercial prospects by: (A) the Indiana economic development corporation; (B) the Indiana destination development corporation; (C) the Indiana finance authority; (D) the ports of Indiana; (E) an economic development commission; (F) the Indiana state department of agriculture; (G) the Indiana White River state park development commission; (H) a local economic development organization that is a nonprofit corporation established under state law whose main purpose is promotion of industrial or business Updated August 2022 by ISBA Legal Service development, retention or expansion of businesses, or development of entrepreneurial activities; or (I) a governing body of a political subdivision. (C) Make one initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration. Notwithstanding IC 5-14-3-4(b)(12), a governing body may release and shall make available for inspection and copying in accordance with IC 5-14-3-3 identifying information concerning prospective appointees not initially excluded from further consideration. An initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration may not reduce the number of prospective appointees to fewer than three unless there are fewer than three prospective appointees. Interviews of prospective appointees must be conducted at a meeting that is open to the public.
