FAFSA Completion Workshop at Lenape Tech

Wendy Dunlap from the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) will be hosting a free FAFSA Completion Workshop for senior students and their parents/guardians on **Wednesday**, **November 13th at 5:30 PM**. This meeting will be held in the **Lenape Tech Library**. FAFSA stands for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid and is what needs to be completed in order to determine eligibility for financial aid for post-secondary education. During this time, you will complete the FAFSA online and have the opportunity to ask any questions. You are welcome to use the computers that we have in the library or bring your own laptop if that's what you prefer.

****Please be aware that there have been delays in the release of the FAFSA this year. It is supposed to be released by December 1st at the latest which means it may not be available for our workshop scheduled for November 13th. If we need to reschedule this workshop, the makeup date will be <u>Tuesday, January 14th</u>. Whether or not we hold it in November will be determined a week before the scheduled workshop date. 2025 Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship

• The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2025 competition. Male and female students compete separately. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university.

• <u>Eligibility</u>: High school senior and U.S. citizen. You **don't** need to be related to a member of the Elks.

- Judging Criteria: Academics, leadership, and financial need.
- Deadline: November 12, 2024

Cooperative education (Co-Op) is a partnership between students, schools, and employers, with specific responsibilities for each. If you are successful in applying for Co-Op, then you will be placed at a local employer where you will earn both money and school credit towards graduation.
