NOVEMBER SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

<u>National Commission for Cooperative Education Scholarships</u> - Offers co-op programs over four years to 10 partnered universities (Universities of Cincinnati and Toledo in Ohio). List of available colleges, as well as on-line application is available at www.waceinc.org, and follow the "Co-op Scholarship Program" link on the lower left. All require a minimum 3.5 GPA and a typed one-page essay. Application deadlines vary by school, from November 1 to February 15.

Ron Brown Scholar Program - Will award \$10,000 scholarships, renewable for up to four years, to eligible African-American students. Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement, exhibit leadership ability, participate in community service activities, and demonstrate financial need. Applications may be downloaded at www.ronbrown.org, click on "Apply" at the top. Applications postmarked by November 1 will also be forwarded to a select number of additional scholarship providers. Application deadline for Ron Brown Scholar Program only is January 9.

<u>Ohio Lions PSA Scholarship</u> – In celebrating its 100th birthday, Ohio Lions is offering a \$500 scholarship to a student for creating a script for a 30 second PSA encouraging people to get involved with their local Lions Club. <u>Ohio Farm Bureau Scholarships</u> - Offers several scholarships. All are based on school and community activities, require 2.5 GPA, letters of recommendation, and an essay. Applications are available on-line at www.ofbf.org/foundation then click on scholarships. Application is available January 1, and deadlines vary by scholarship.

<u>OU-L Kilburger Scholarship</u> - Scholarship to Ohio University-Lancaster, up to full tuition. You must be a resident of, and have attended, a Fairfield County high school. Award is based on academics, need, and activities. Students must file FAFSA and have been accepted to OUL to be considered. Applications will be sent to high schools in late November. See Mr. Gaulke at that time. Application deadline for all materials is **January 15.**

<u>Engineers Foundation of Ohio Scholarships</u> - Scholarships offered to students who intend to major in engineering at several universities in Ohio. All require minimum 3.0 GPA and either 1100 SAT (600M/500R/C) or ACT (M29/E25). Some scholarships have additional criteria. You must enroll in a degree-granting program at an accredited US institution of post-secondary education. Students do not apply for specific scholarships, but are automatically considered in each category for which they qualify. Applicants must be planning a career in government service at the local, state or national level. OACAC C. L. Warren Memorial Heritage Scholarship - Will award a scholarship of \$1,000 to a student who has demonstrated commitment to cultural and intellectual diversity. Requires 3.0 GPA, need, personal statement, guidance counselor recommendation, and acceptance to an Ohio college or university. Contact Mr. Gaulke for application information. Application deadline is **January 20.**

<u>Ohio JCI Senate Scholarship</u> (<u>Junior Chamber of Commerce</u>) – will award six total scholarships of \$1,000 each in two categories, academic-based and need-based.
