Curriculum

Novi High School offers a number of advanced academic programs. The purpose of these programs is to provide challenging college preparatory programs for students.

- Twenty-two Advanced Placement courses are offered in Biology, Calculus AB & BC, Chemistry, Computer Science, English Language, English Literature, Environmental Science, European History, French, Japanese, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Physics C: Mechanics, Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism, Psychology, Research, Seminar, Spanish, Statistics, US Government and Politics, US History.
- Fifteen IB Diploma Programme courses are offered in Biology HL, Business Management HL, Physics SL, Language Arts HL, Spanish SL, . French SL, Japanese SL, German SL, Visual Art HL, History SL & HL, Math SL, Sports-Exercise-Health Science HL, Career Core, and Theory of Knowledge.
- Three Honors courses offered in Geometry, Algebra 2 and Pre-Calculus

Juniors and Seniors have access to Career and Technical Education (CTE) at the Oakland Schools Technical Center (OSTC). •

Students are limited to only taking AP exams for courses they are enrolled in, with the exception of AP language exams for native speakers.
