





YOUTH SWIM LESSONS



Classes are designed for the child's ability, not age. Use the descriptions below to help determine your child's placement level. All classes follow the American Red Cross level quidelines.

Level Descriptions

Preschool Aquatics Level: (ages 3-5)

The purpose of this class is to orient pre-school age children to the pool environment and get them comfortable in the water. Parents will not enter the water.

Level 1: Beginner (ages 5+)

This is our beginner class designed for kids ages 5+ who cannot fully submerge, glide, or swim independently. The focus of this class is independent submersion, as well as swimming, floating, and gliding very short distances with and without support.

Level 2: Advanced Beginner

Students should be comfortable in the water, be able to submerge themselves completely. The focus of this class is learning to swim away from the wall short distances using the fundamentals of front and back crawl. Students will also master floating, and streamlined gliding for approximately 10-15 feet.

Level 3: Intermediate

Students should be able to demonstrate front crawl while breathing to the side and back crawl for a minimum of 15 feet. Swimmers will continue improving front and back crawl while increasing distance. Students will practice swimming in deep water. Diving and treading water are introduced.

Level 4: Advanced

Students should be able to swim front and back crawl at least one length of pool with good technique. Swimmers will begin swimming full lengths of front and back crawl. Breaststroke and butterfly are introduced. Students will also master treading water and diving.

CSTP: Competitive Swim Team Preparation

Students should be able to swim a full length of all four competitive strokes using correct technique. Swimmers will continue learning advanced techniques for all four competitive strokes while increasing distance.
