- Freshman Summer Bridge Program Monday, August 19th Friday, August 23rd 2024; @8:30am-1:00PM. Summer Bridge is MANDATORY for all ninth grade students. We look forward to seeing you there!
- **Student Orientations** All students are required to attend their grade level orientations before school starts. All orientations are held in-person.
 - o Senior Orientation: Monday, August 26th, 2024; 8:30AM -11:00AM
 - o Junior Orientation: Monday, August 26th, 2024; 12:30PM -3:00PM
 - Sophomore Orientation: Friday, August 30th, 2024; 8:30AM -11:00AM
 - o Freshman Orientation: Friday, August 30th, 2024; 12:30PM -3:00PM
- First Day of School Tuesday, September 3rd, 2024.
- **Daily Start Time & Dismissal** The school day begins at 8:15AM and ends at 3:05PM. Students are expected to be in class and ready for instruction daily at 8:15AM.
- Attendance Students who attend school every day succeed academically and socially and outperform their peers who are absent. Students are expected to be present in school every day.
- **Lunch Applications** All families are required to complete a lunch application for the 24-25 school year. Please complete the lunch application here.
- School Uniforms All students must be in uniform every day. The uniform code is as follows: Kelly Green polo shirts with black pants or skirt. Hunter Green Uniforms will no longer be permitted. Uniforms may be purchased at Flynn O'Hara -196-198 Ferry Street or Kids Place 311 Ferry Street, Newark, NJ.
- Arrival doors for students All students will enter at the Chapman street entrance. Student entry begins at 7:45AM daily.
