

October 2023 Family Circle Lesson

In October's Family Circle lesson, students were paired up to work on a collaborative drawing challenge. Before diving into the challenge, students took the time to get to know their partners. They practiced greeting each other, asking questions, and actively listening to responses. Then, the drawing challenge commenced! With a piece of paper taped to one partner's back, the other partner drew a simple picture using shapes.
