#### **Financial Aid Night at Lenape Tech**

Wendy Dunlap from the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) will be hosting a Financial Aid Night at Lenape Tech on **Thursday, October 19th at 5:30 PM**. You will learn about different types of financial aid, including the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which is required to determine eligibility for most student aid programs such as the PA State Grant, Federal Pell Grant, institutional awards, and federal student and parent loans. There have been updates/changes to the FAFSA for this year which will also be shared. Attendees will also be briefed on Pennsylvania-specific aid programs, as well as the importance of minimizing student loan debt and applying for grants and scholarships to help pay for education costs.

#### **2023 Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship**

- The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2024 competition. Male and female students compete separately. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$7,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university.
- Eligibility: High school senior and U.S. citizen. You don't need to be related to a member of the Elks.
- Judging Criteria: Academics, leadership, and financial need.
- Deadline: November 13, 2023

#### Elks National Foundation Scholarships for Elks Families: Legacy Awards

- The Legacy Awards provide \$4,000 scholarships for children and grandchildren of dues-paying Elk members. The ENF offers a total of 350 national awards.
