The next time your child comes home frustrated after receiving a low grade or when having difficulty understanding a lesson, try focusing on the next steps they can take to improve. It's not that they don't understand something. It's that they don't understand yet! Do they need to put some extra effort into studying? Do they need to ask for help? Teach them to learn from their mistakes and move on. The grade is not nearly as valuable as the learning that comes as a result.
