

### Sun River Valley School District Newsletter October/November/ December 2023

Please be sure that students dress appropriately for school, recess and extracurricular activities. Elementary students need to be prepared for various types of weather during recess. In the event a bus should happen to break down, sandals and open toed shoes are not going to be appropriate in winter weather. Parents, encourage student drivers to take the bus home on days when there is an early dismissal from school. Oftentimes, inexperienced drivers are safer taking the bus. Their cars can be picked up from the school parking lot when it is safe to drive. Parents, review the following with your children:

#### Dress appropriately for cold, icy weather.

- Allow extra time to get to your bus stop.
- Stand away from where the bus stops. Buses need extra room when there is ice and snow on the roadway.
- Use the handrails when boarding or exiting the bus to prevent slipping.
- Do not stand or play on snow piles at the bus stop.
- Do not throw snowballs at the bus or at anyone.
- Never try to retrieve an item that falls around or underneath the bus. Instead, always report such an incident to the bus driver.
- Remind student drivers in your house to keep windshields and roofs clear of snow and ice.

#### Additional tips for a safe ride:

While school buses are, by far, the safest way for students to travel, children need to do their part to stay alert and aware of their surroundings to prevent injury.

#### **Getting on the Bus**

- When waiting for the bus, stay away from traffic and avoid roughhousing or other behavior that can lead to carelessness.
- Do not stray onto the roads, alleys or private property.
- Line up away from the street or road as the bus approaches.
- Wait until the bus has stopped and the door opens before approaching the bus.
- Use the handrail when boarding.



- Don't speak loudly or make loud noises that could distract the driver.
- Stay in your seat and face the front of the bus.
- Don't put your head, arms or hands out the window.
- Keep aisles clear of books and bags.
- Get your belongings together before reaching your stop.
  Wait for the bus to stop completely before getting up from your seat.

#### **Getting Off the Bus**

- When waiting for the bus, stay away from traffic and avoid roughhousing or other behavior that can lead to carelessness.
- Do not stray onto the roads, alleys or private property.
- Line up away from the street or road as the bus approaches.
- Wait until the bus has stopped and the door opens before approaching the bus.
- Use the handrail when boarding.

#### **Understanding School Bus Lights**

When you see a school bus slowing down or stopping, it's not just the bus that you need to have your eyes on – but the surrounding area too. Children, wait at least several feet away from a bus and often cross the street when they're boarding or getting off the bus. This is why you must stop for school buses, and don't attempt to pass.

#### Illegal School Bus Passing

Illegal school bus passing poses a significant threat to children and others on the road. In every state, it is illegal for you to pass a school bus while the stop-arm is extended and the red lights are flashing.

Learn the school bus laws in your state and always follow them, as well as the flashing lights that school bus drivers use to alert you. ~ Mr. Dave Marzolf, Superintendent



#### Counselor's Corner – November/December

Greetings! By the time you read this, students will have completed the 1st quarter of the school year! October 26th was the final day of quarter one; grades were posted by Monday, October 30th. Be sure to log in to Infinite Campus to check your child's grades, and if you have any questions,

please feel free to reach out to any of your child's teachers.

On September 21st, seniors visited the University of Providence for the annual Montana College & Career Fair. Many colleges and trade schools from across the state as well as those from out-of-state were in attendance to provide information regarding post-secondary programs. Military personnel as well as local businesses were on hand to discuss a variety of career opportunities available. An estimated 1,000 students made their way through the fair that day, gaining valuable information and lots of swag from vendors. Simms students received compliments from the fair organizers for their respectful behavior – way to represent Tigers!

Seniors have had a few visits from different representatives since school started; the University of Providence visited on the 18th of September to discuss opportunities and programs on their campus, and Dace Steinke from the Montana Air National Guard visited with both seniors and juniors about programs and benefits offered from their military branch. Michelle Crazy with Reach Higher Montana visited with sophomores on October 4th about careers and how to research career interests. Ms. Crazy also visited with the seniors on October 12th regarding scholarship opportunities; she will return to visit with the seniors in December for those planning to file the Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to help fund college. She will provide valuable information for completing this application. We are so fortunate to have community members who are willing to take the time to drive out to Simms to provide our students with such valuable information!

On October 10th, juniors took the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) in the gymnasium. The PSAT is a standardized test administered by the College Board and cosponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation in the United States. This test is excellent practice for the ACT test, which will be administered in the spring of 2024. It also affords students the opportunity to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program and other scholarships if they score high enough. Last year the test was paper & pencil, this year it was completely digital. A few of the juniors took the time to run a partial practice test to make sure our system could handle the secure browser (it could). The juniors made it through the exam with no issues and displayed exemplary behavior. Results will be released around November 6th.




