Priority in the selection process will be given to Ogemaw Hill Snowmobile Club members and immediate family members, Michigan Snowmobile ORV Association (MISORVA) members and immediate family, or students who have completed a Michigan DNR Snowmobile Safety Course.

Include one letter of recommendation from a School Administrator, Teacher, Counselor, Coach, or Employer. If more space is needed to answer any question, simply staple another sheet to the application.
