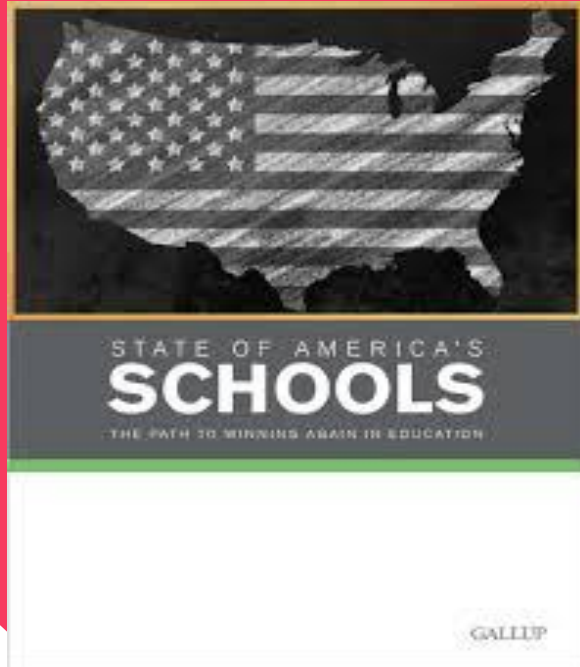

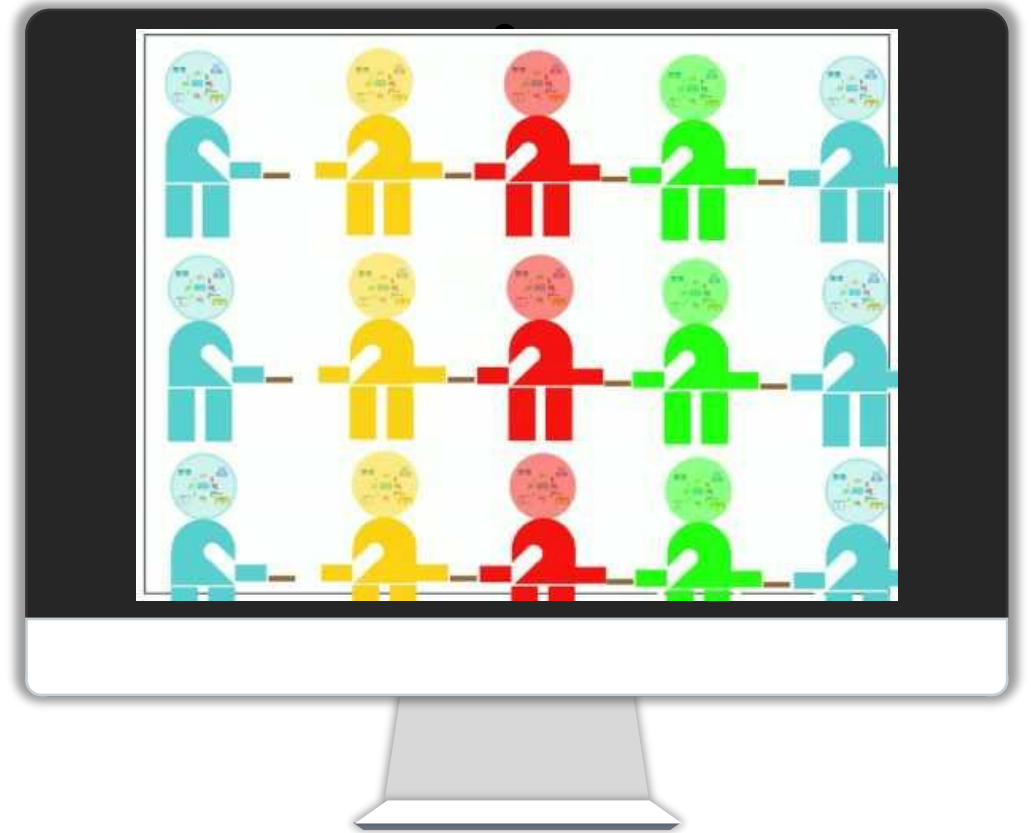
- Following a shared schedule, families read the selected book - a high quality full children's novel
