WORD STUDY (SPELLING)

In word study students will be focusing on reinforcing their phonics sills as well as building foundational skills. There will not be a spelling test for the first couple weeks of school. Each student will be given a spelling assessment some time during those two weeks. When we are ready to begin spelling, a list sill be sent home every Monday and students will we tested over those words on the following Friday.

READING

We will be beginning a new ELA program from McGraw Hill called Wonders. This is a great program and I look forward to this new program.

The first couple of weeks in September will be spent completing DRAs (developmental reading assessment) and working through the *Wonders Routines* which will prepare the students for small groups and independent work during their ELA block. All students will be grouped according to their DRAs to ensure they are reading on their level with their respective peers.



WRITING

The month of September will be spent reviewing paragraph writing. Students will be expected to write a well-organized paragraph that includes a topic sentence, at least 3 details that support the topic sentence and a concluding sentence. This will help prepare them for their first writing assignment which will be an opinion essay.
