Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: Algebra 1/ Geometry

I am pleased to inform you that your child is eligible to earn five high school **elective credits in mathematics** at Mahwah High School while enrolled in their current Algebra 1 or Geometry course at Ramapo Ridge Middle School if they meet the criteria outlined below.

Mahwah Public School District Policy #5460 allows students enrolled in our middle school to receive mathematics credit for Algebra 1/ Geometry if a student successfully meets the academic and attendance requirements. Students entering the high school the following academic year will then continue their course work sequence with Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus in order to be fully prepared to take the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA) and have a solid foundation for advanced mathematics in college. MHS students are required to take a three year sequence of mathematics while in grades 9-12 to be eligible for a diploma.

Enclosed is specific information about this Option Two Program. There is no cost associated with this particular program. In order to receive high school credit a student must attend and successfully complete the appropriate program requirements below.

These include:

- Required seat time of 200 minutes per week
- Regular attendance in compliance with the district's attendance policy. As per the district's attendance policy 5200, a secondary student will be denied credit on the 13th unexcused countable absence in a full year course and the 7th unexcused countable absence in a semester course. However, a secondary student may also be dropped from a course or denied course credit when he/she has been absent from greater than twenty five percent or more of the class sessions (45 days out of 180 class sessions in a full year course), regardless of whether it is a unexcused countable or excused non-countable absence, except absences for the observance of a religious holiday or absences caused by a student's suspension will not count toward the total.
- Minimum final course grade of 80.0 %

No response is required on your part. Students who meet these criteria will automatically have this course added to their Mahwah High School transcript and be placed in the next course in sequence. Students enrolled in Algebra 1 who do not meet the above criteria will be re-enrolled in Algebra 1 for the next school year. Students enrolled in Geometry who do not meet the above criteria will be re-enrolled in Geometry for the next school year.

Option Two Programs and Guidelines (N.J.A.C. 6A:8-5.1(a)lii)

Option Two extends flexibility at the local level by allowing schools to choose from an array of models for developing activities or programs linked to the Core Curriculum Content Standards, such as: interdisciplinary and theme-based programs; independent study; co-curricular and extracurricular activities; magnet programs; student exchange programs; distance learning opportunities; internships; community service; or other structured learning experiences.

General Procedures

Teachers and instructors must be certified and properly licensed by the appropriate state agencies. Teachers and instructors must present certification upon request and be approved by the Board of Education.

The teacher or instructor will record student achievement and attendance for the duration of the course. Progress will be reported every five weeks in the form of progress reports and report cards to parents as in any other course. This documentation, as well as a statement of assurances, will be submitted to the Director of Guidance before credit is awarded.

The student must attend and successfully complete the appropriate program requirements with a **minimum final grade of 80.0%** in order to receive high school credit. Credit is based upon verification of attendance as indicated by the district's attendance policy and a final course grade of 80.0% or higher. Students who do not meet the criteria will start their high school math sequence in Algebra 1 or Geometry.

Prior administrative approval by the department supervisor, director of guidance, and principal must be obtained before enrolling in any option two programs.

Any costs incurred as a result of an option two program will be the responsibility of the parent/ guardian. The Board of Education will not assume any responsibility for any fees associated with this program.

Such approved courses are listed separately on a student's transcript with the grade and location of where the program was taken. <i>Courses taken prior to grade 9 are not included in the GPA or class rank.</i> Course credits will count toward graduation requirements.
