Levels of Placement


- 1. Returning afterschool student, income below \$75,000, single parent household working, MLE, homeless, voucher, continuity of care
- 2. New afterschool student, income between \$76-150,000, two parent household both working or single parent household working
- 3. New afterschool student, income above \$200,000 and two parent both working or two parent household with only one working

- How do we distinguish between those who need a childcare program versus those who are looking for enrichment.
