AREA SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE TO SENIORS

SFM Foundation	Offers up to \$10,000 per year, for up to five years to students whose parent was killed or seriously injured in workplace accidents while working for Minnesota or Iowa employers. Deadline date is March 31, 2020.
Little Theatre of Owatonna	Offers scholarships to graduating seniors from Steele County who are accepted at an accredited two or four-year college for a full-time course of study. Applicant should have experience and/or interest in the performing arts. Deadline date is April 3, 2020.
AFA – Agriculture Futures of America	Offers two \$3,200 scholarships to graduating seniors with plans to attend a 4-year school or technical college with plans to continue to a 4-year program to pursue an agricultural degree. Applicant must be a resident of Freeborn County. Deadline date is March 11, 2020.
Freeborn County Corn and Soybean Growers	Offers two \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors with plans to attend a 4-year school or technical college with plans to continue to a 4-year program to pursue an agricultural degree. Applicant must be a resident of Freeborn County. Deadline date is March 11, 2020.
Freeborn County Farm Bureau	Offers a \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior who is accepted or in the process of acceptance to an accredited college or university for a degree in agriculture or a home economics related program. Applicant must be a resident of Freeborn County. Deadline date is March 27, 2020.
Allina Health-MN Athletes in Sports Medicine	Offers two \$2,500 scholarships to one male and one female graduating high school student athlete who intend to pursue a professional career in sports medicine. Applicant must be attending a 4-year college or university within the U.S., involved in interscholastic sports all four years in high school and be from Minnesota. Deadline date is February 17, 2020.
Luck of the Draw-Freeborn Mower Coop. Electric	Offers five \$1,000 scholarships to a graduating senior planning to be a full-time student at an accredited college or university in the fall of 2020. Applicants parents must be an active member of FMCS. Deadline date is March 16, 2020.

Applicant must be pursuing a career in a medical related education program at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university or vocational-technical college for the entire upcoming academic year. Deadline date is April 15, 2020.
Steele Co. Robert Chladek Academic Agribusiness	Offers up to \$5,000 scholarship to any high school senior who resides in Steele County. Applicant must be planning to study agribusiness at a college or university. Deadline date is April 25, 2020.
