## How to Apply:

### Application Deadline

Applications must be received in the Office of Admissions by:

**April 1** - fall semester or summer session

**November 1** - spring semester

This application form in PDF format is designed for you to fill out on-screen, then print and mail to the University.

Or, if you prefer, you may print the application, fill it out by hand and then mail it.

The deadline to apply for scholarship is February 1, 20F€. Please note that some scholarships have earlier deadlines and there are scholarship selection committees that may begin awarding scholarships earlier. You are encouraged to apply for admission/scholarships early during your senior year of high school. While the freshman scholarship deadline is February 1, 20F€, applicants are encouraged to retake the ACT and/or SAT tests through April 30, 20F€. A student's scores on the national or residual tests taken after April 30, 20F€ will not be used for scholarship consideration (except to qualify for the Oklahoma Academic Scholars Program which allows students to take national exams through June 20F€).
