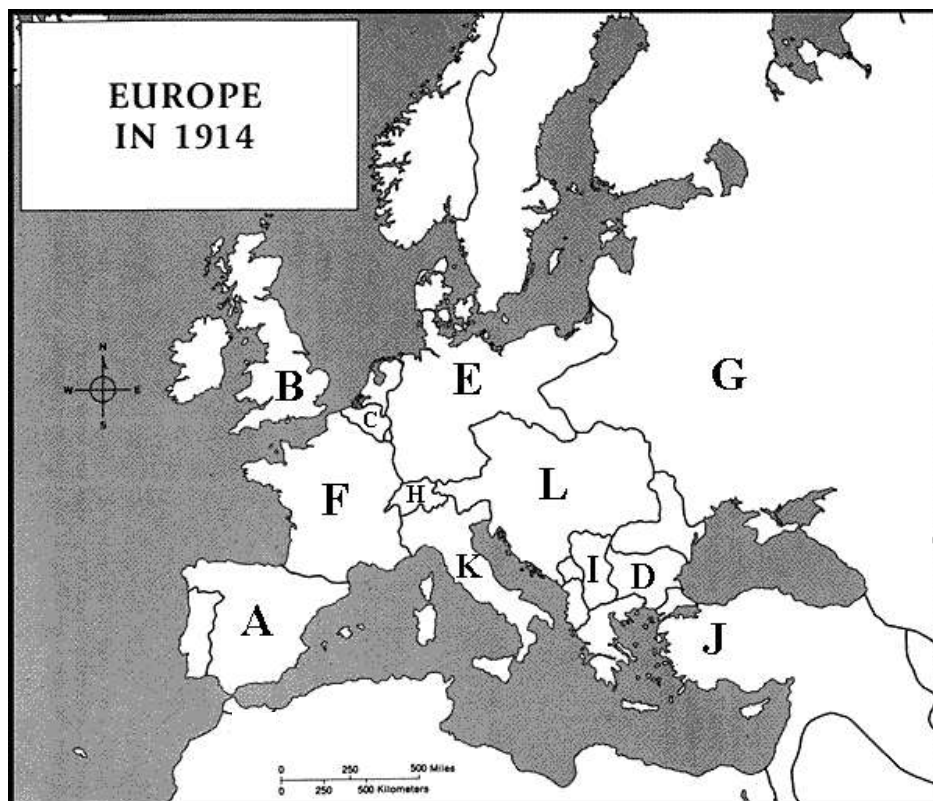


# Outbreak of World War I Review

4. Why was the First Battle of the Marne so significant for France? How did the fighting at the end of Battle of the Marne lead German forces to dig trenches? In your answer explain why trench warfare developed at the beginning of World War I.
5. Why did both sides use trenches during World War I? How did troops construct these trenches? Why was trench warfare so deadly?
