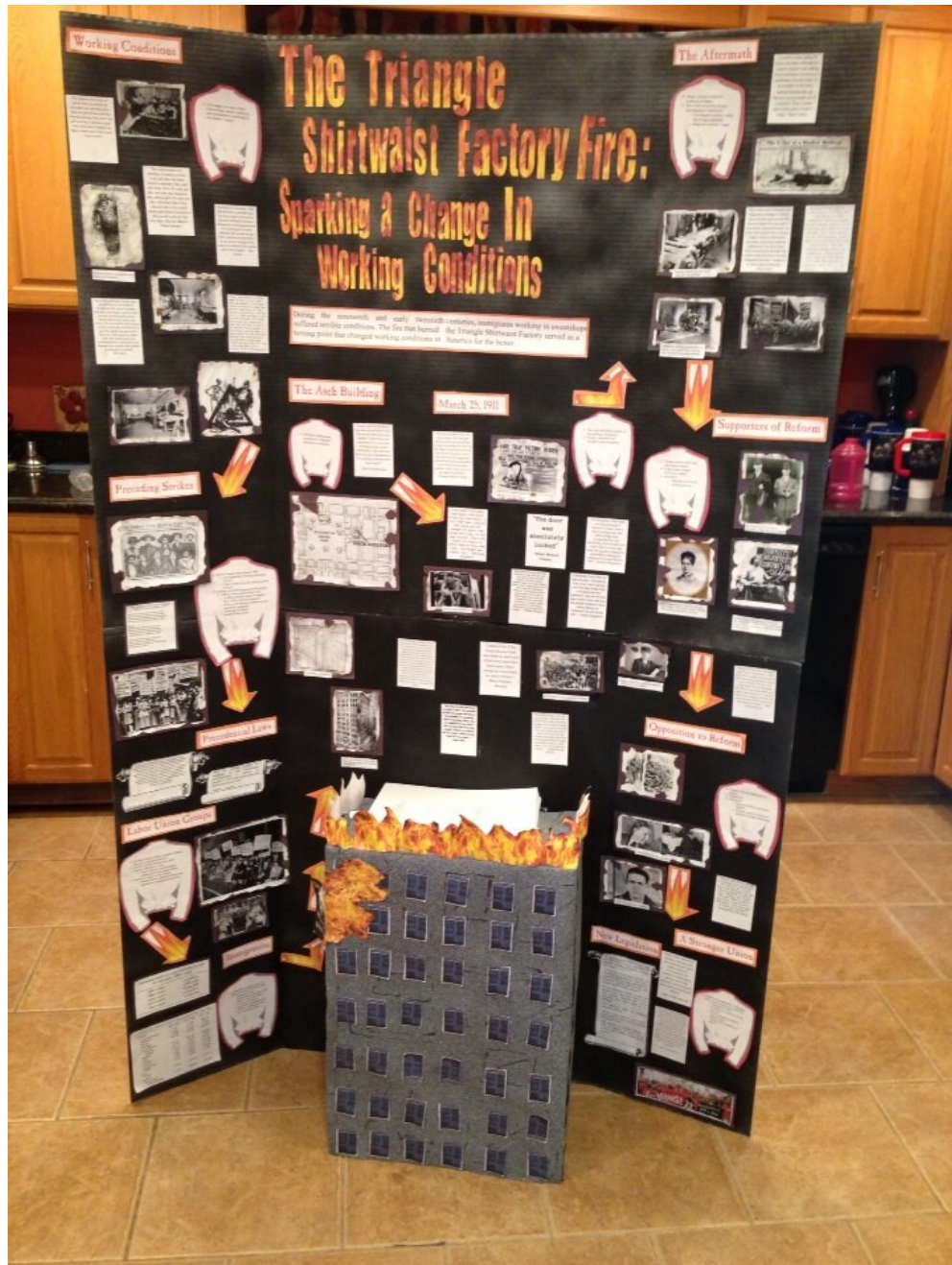

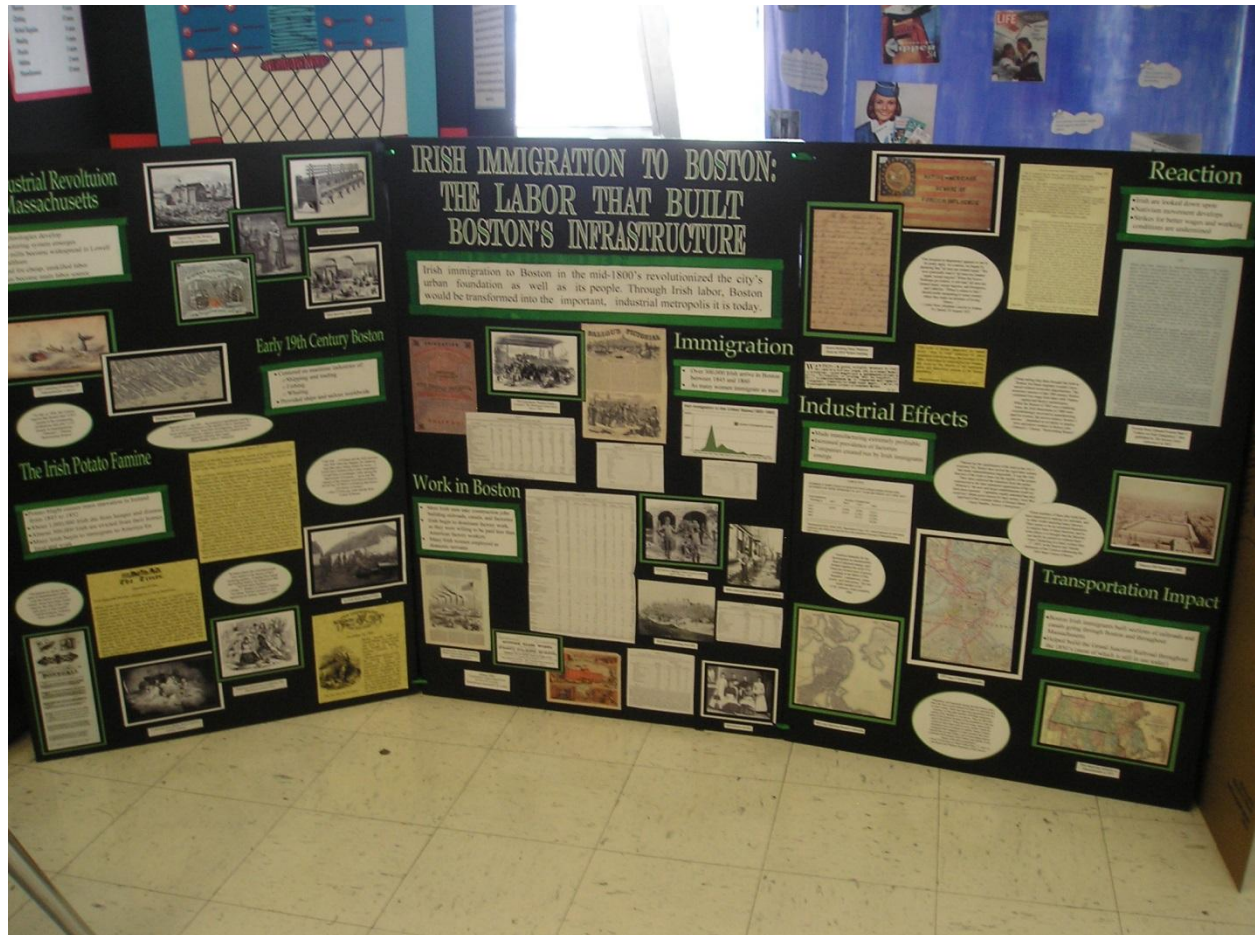

 - Shipping and trading
 - Fishing
 - Whaling
- Provided ships and sailors worldwide

- Over 300,000 Irish arrive in Boston between 1845 and 1860
- As many women immigrate as men

- Most Irish men take construction jobs building railroads, canals, and factories

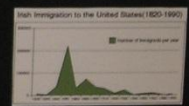
