You Have Options:

- **Visit PreferredOne.com** - to locate participating providers in your PreferredOne network.
- **Call Your Clinic** - if your clinic is open, they can provide the best advice on the level of care you need— scheduling an appointment or recommending urgent care or a emergency room.
- **Convenience Care Clinics** - offer easy access for common illnesses and injuries.
- **Urgent Care** - Generally, provides after-hours and some weekend care for conditions that are not life-threatening and require more immediate attention.
- **E-Visits** - for minor health conditions go online 24/7.
- **Emergency Rooms** - For life- threatening conditions that require immediate emergency care.

IMAGING: MRI, CT & PET/CT SCANS - WHERE DO I GO FOR SERVICES?

PreferredOne maintains a high level of quality imaging providers while managing costs.

Tips for being a proactive health care consumer for imaging services:

- Ask for a good faith estimate of the procedure you are having done.
- In general, a free standing imaging provider will be 30-50% less expensive than a hospital-based provider.
- Minnesota law requires that all imaging providers have available estimated reimbursement levels for their top 50 procedures.
- Go to PreferredOne.com, register/login as a member and select *Imaging Providers* in the Medical Cost Tools section to view provider cost comparisons.

GENERIC vs. BRANDS

GENERIC MEDICATIONS CAN SAVE YOU 40% OR MORE OVER BRAND NAME DRUGS.

Generic medications are required to have the same active ingredient and medical effect as a brand name drug. Almost every drug class has one or more generically available medications in it and can save 80% or more over the brand name drug.

The next time you get a prescription, ask your doctor or pharmacist if there is a generic available.
