

2440 SUMMER SCHOOL

The Board of Education shall require a summer school program for children in grades five through eight who fail Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Science or forfeit promotion to the next grade level.

Pupils eligible for the summer school program of this district shall include resident pupils eligible for regular attendance in the district.

Successful completion of summer course work will allow a student to be promoted to the next grade. Summer school is an option, but should a parent(s) or legal guardian(s) choose to not remediate the failure in a course through a summer school program, the student will be retained for the next school year at the grade level the failure was attained. All costs for the summer school program will be incurred by the parent.
